

SPOTLIGHT ON MAY PROGRAM

By this time EPFG membership should have received the registration materials for the 4th Annual Awards Banquet and Education program. This year's event will be conducted over a two day period, May 3 & 4. The location again this year is at the DoubleTree Inn in Tukwila. This event takes tremendous planning, by the Board and dedicated volunteers. The program for 1997 reflects those efforts. On Saturday May 3rd EPFG is playing host to PPFA's ReCertification Program. This seminar is required for those CPF's who received their designation after January 1, 1994, it is also recommended for all CPF's. The ReCertification Course covers recent innovations in framing, keeps CPF's current with advances in the field and maintains the value of the CPF credential. The RE Certification course is led by a team of experienced instructors with practical framing experience and expertise in preservation. Each faculty member has been trained in curriculum materials and effective training techniques. The instructor for the May 3rd course will be Dennis Tilley, CPF. The CPF exam will run concurrently on Saturday. Registration for this exam must be made through PPFA in Richmond, Virginia.

Sunday-May 4th marks the big day! Four classes will fill the day's education slate. The morning classes include National educator Kaye Evans, CPF presenting a program on Preservation Framing for fine art on paper. Evans has been an instructor for PPFA, Nielsen/Bainbridge and Williamson Moulding. Toby Freccia

Framing Competitions to be featured in May

During the annual education program in May, the Evergreen Picture Framers' Guild will also sponsor the regional Print Framing competition and the chapter Open Framing competition. This is the qualifying event for those interested in advancing to PPFA's National Hall of Fame Competition in Cincinnati. Each entrant in the print competition will be framing a commemorative sheet of stamps featuring the work of Georgia O'Keefe. The stamps are enhanced with the image and words of the artist. Historically the EPFG winners have fared extremely well at the National Level, with several first place awards. The chapter prize structure for the print competition is:

1st place: Airfare to Cincinnati to compete at the National Level.

2nd place: \$100.00

3rd place: \$50.00

1st place: \$1,500.00 & featured on the front cover of *Picture Framing Magazine*

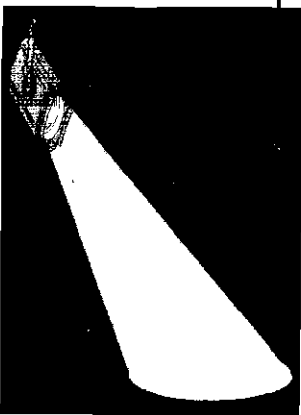
2nd place: \$300.00

April meeting notes- judging criteria

The April general chapter meeting was held on Tuesday the 8th at Frame Design Northwest in Issaquah. With 28 in attendance a review of the NEW judging criteria was presented. Over the past two years Jodi Norton and Linda Watson have been involved with PPFA in updating the criteria used in judging framing competitions. All the rules and restrictions were addressed, including the requirement of having a color slide of your entry upon registration at the National Level. This is a must for all pieces being judged in Cincinnati. The new criteria now includes much more specific details to be considered when judging. The point system remains essentially the same. Some of the key elements that were discussed was the use of multiple techniques. Judges are looking for a variety of techniques to be used in competition, however, they must be justified and work effortlessly with the piece. A competition piece should compliment the work it surrounds without distraction. It was also explained how the judges work. Initially the judges with stand back and scan the entire display of pieces to see which ones stand out and make the best overall impression. After that cursory evaluation the detailed judging begins. Once every element of the framing has been examined, the judges again stand back to insure that all the components flow smoothly from the art outward to the frame. This presentation was an bonus for those who are considering entering the competition locally in May.

A special thanks to Sue Bye and Shelly Bedsaul of Frame Dame/Blue Heron Gallery for providing some of their award winning framing as examples.

The Open Framing competition is a chapter event. The Open competition has no restrictions on design or subject matter. The purpose is to encourage framers to invent new and creative techniques, or to combine traditional techniques for a new look. Those participating in the chapter event, must still qualify at the Cincinnati show. If they place in the preliminary judging the piece will advance to Hall of Fame judging. The EPFG is a chance to warm up before heading off to compete at National. The prize structure for the Open Framing Competition is as follows:

1st place: \$100.00

2nd & 3rd place: ribbons

1st place: \$1,500.00 and featured on the cover of *Picture Framing Magazine*

2nd place: \$300.00

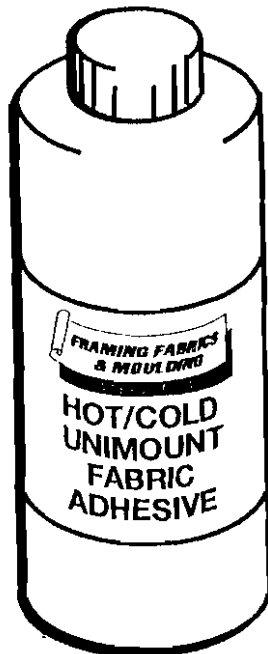

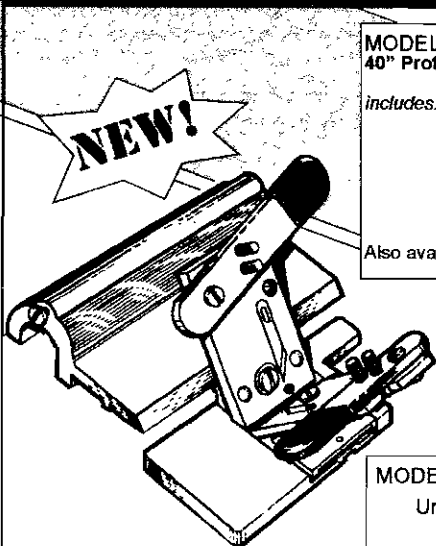

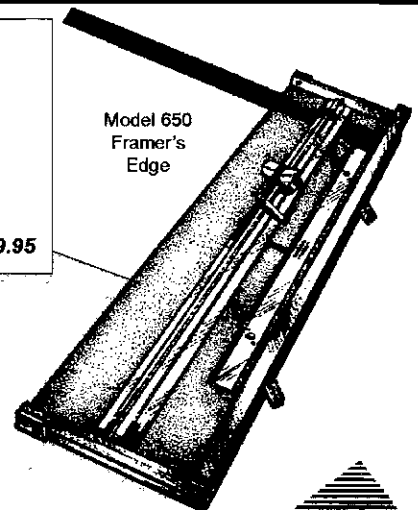
