We may have met by now through a phone call, if not let me introduce myself— Nancy White, "The Art Doctor". I have been restoring art since 1963, that's almost 40 years. I'm looking forward to meeting you, probably through a phone call and I would be very happy to help you or your customers with art related problems. Some problems are easy to resolve with just a call, others will need to come into my shop. I don't give out my address as I work in my home and I don't want drop in business, I've found over the years that talking to the customer first and making an appointment works very well for both of us.

MY RESTORATION SERVICES INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING------

- 1- cleaning, mending, lining, inpainting, and varnishing oil paintings.
- 2-cleaning, mending paper born art, replacing missing pieces, inpainting.
- 3-repair of Japanese screens and scrolls.
- 4-repair of art objects and that can be most anything that I'm able to fix.
- 5-cleaning and casting or carving missing parts of frames.

In most cases I tell the customer they can have a new frame made for less than it will cost to have a frame repaired, there are some exceptions.

THERE ARE SOME THINGS I DO NOT REPAIR—porcelain, fabrics, parchment, and most photographs with a few exceptions.

I have gathered some excellent references to give when it's something I don't restore. I feel I have at least helped the person in some way, they leave with some helpful information and may feel good about coming back at another time with an item I can repair. I really believe in making the customer happy if at all possible. I hope this will tell you a little about who I am and what I do. Please call with any questions you may have. Sincerely,







Some of the ideas for weathering the financial tough times were taking out ads in the yellow pages as large as possible. Hunting down corporate sales, offering work for local charitable groups. I was also wanting to put the recipe in for one of the fantastic morsels put out for us at the Bounds' gallery.

Bavarian Potato Salad

- 8-10 medium-sized Potatoes
- 1/4 cup white or red onion, finely diced
- 1 English cucumber, peeled and finely sliced
- 1/8 cup parsley, finely chopped Steam potatoes in skins until tender when tested with a knife. Let cool; peel skins, and slice finely. Add onion cucumber, and parsley.

Marinade

- 1/2 cup canola oil
- 1/2 cup apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 teaspoon dried mustard
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon fresh-ground pepper

Mix marinade ingredients in jar, and shake well. Pour over potatoes and cucumbers, and toss; let stand at room temperature for 20 minutes before serving. Serves 6-8.
